The Korean-American Educational Researchers Association (KAERA) is pleased to announce the Call for Proposal for the 36th annual US-Korea Conference (<u>UKC 2023</u>) organized by Korean-American Scientists and Engineers Association (KSEA). The conference theme is "Discovery, Innovation, and Dissemination for Transformative Impact." KAERA will lead a technical group symposium (<u>D-1</u>. Education Research, <u>STEM and Social Sciences</u>).

We invite leading experts and young researchers in emerging technology and DEI (Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion) in Education. The first session focuses on the integration of advanced technologies into education. These advances brought changes in the way we learn and teach thereby significantly transforming the educational landscape. With this in mind, it will cover a wide range of topics, including but not limited to the ethical implications of AI technology in education, immersive learning experiences through AR or VR, online or flipped learning, gamification, as well as various pedagogies and teaching models. Please submit a <u>one-page paper</u> to deliver presentations at the Technical Group Symposium. The <u>one-page paper template</u> must be completed by May 30, 2023. During the submission process, please select D-1 as a technical group where the paper will be considered for an oral presentation. All papers must be written in English. The submitted papers will be reviewed and selected by each Technical Group Symposium Chairs. Accepted papers will be published in the electronic version of the UKC 2023 Proceedings.

If your paper is accepted, you will get registration discount (\$100) and a travel support. The detailed information about travel support will be available later. We encourage you to join the KSEA member to get extra registration discount as well.
